The Promise of Blessing

The truth we begin from is that God, who is sovereign, all-powerful and the creator and one who sustains all things:

- · Does great and marvellous deeds
- Loves us
- · Desires to give us abundantly more than we can ask or imagine

When this truth becomes a deep 'knowing' within our hearts and minds, we can expect God to do incredible and miraculous things, when we call forth the promises within His word. With each of God's blessings in the Bible, there was always a special anointing- an impartation of supernatural power that enabled the people to be blessed. God's blessings:

- Made impossible things possible

As followers of Jesus and heirs of God's Kingdom, we can take authority and claim the rich inheritance promised to us and our families, our children and grandchildren and for generations still to come.

The Concept of Blessing

In the Bible, Abraham was the first man to receive the blessings of a covenant with God. This covenant (promise) contained seven promises, found in Genesis 12:2-3:

- · I will make you a great nation
- · I will bless you
- · I will make your name great
- · You shall be a blessing
- · I will bless those who bless you
- · I will curse him who curses you
- · In you all the families of the earth shall be blessed

So how do we become recipients of those same promises made to Abraham?

By activating the power of blessing! We do that by speaking words of blessing based on God's word and the promises we find within it. Giving our lives to God and being members of His family means that we receive full rights of the blessing of our Father and we can pass on His blessing to our loved ones. A great starting point is to fully understand the many promises of which we are heirs through faith in Jesus Christ.

If you are a parent, carer, grandparent, you have spiritual authority over your household and power to speak blessing into the lives of your children and grandchildren. Your words of blessing are energised by the power of God when you speak them.

Over the next 100 days it is our prayer that we join together as parents, carers, grandparents, aunties, uncles and mother and father figures in our community to daily bless our children.

With your eyes fixed on Jesus and your heart set on loving others as He loves you, you will not have a judgemental, unkind or critical spirit. I bless you with a firm control of your words, actions and behaviours. They will be rooted in love, patience, forgiveness, kindness and empathy, all the days of your life.

I bless you with the intelligence to be self-aware and reflective, with a desire to exemplify the person God has created you to be in Christ Jesus. May you be willing to accept criticism, correction or advice and may you always be open-minded and understanding of the views of others.

May you disagree in love, rather than let differences bring strife and disunity. I bless you to bless your own soul. May you consistently tell your mind to pay attention and your soul to line up with His words and thoughts about you. When you live and walk in His blessing, you begin to do so much more with the things entrusted into your hands.

I bless you to speak words of kindness and strength over yourself. Declaring His promises and greatest blessings for your life! I bless you in the name of Jesus, to refuse to allow discouragement to divert your course or cause deep wounds in your heart. Day 55: Your Path
