- Healthy with a church culture forming disciples who extend God's Kingdom

CCV is a vibrant, pioneering, missional community in the north coast of Northern Ireland with around 700 people attending Sunday services. We have a significant compassion ministry and a staff team (including Compassion) of approximately 40 people.

Job Summary

We are seeking to appoint a Senior Pastor or Senior Pastors who share our heart to see a healthy, missional, supernatural and compassionate church community pursuing God's heart for the Causeway Coast area.

We are open to appointing an individual or a couple to the role of Senior Pastor(s). If it is a couple, we would explore at interview how each person's employment would be structured.

Following a review process and the resignation of the previous Senior Pastors in October 2023, the church has been through a reset process. The ideal candidate will have led in a large church context and have experience in creating and maintaining healthy culture.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

The role of Senior Pastor involves overall spiritual and operational leadership of CCV church and oversight of Vineyard compassion (VC) working with the Compassion CEO. Core responsibilities include.

- 1. Uphold values, create culture and set vision and strategy
 - a. Seeking God's will and direction and working together with senior leadership, you will take responsibility for defining and upholding values, creating culture and setting vision and strategy that will help to lead CCV into becoming an increasingly Jesus-centred church which is both inwardly strong and outwardly focused.
 - b. You will model these in all aspects of your personal life.
 - c. You will work closely with the Vineyard movement, and you will play an active and engaged role at both Ireland and VCUKI levels.
- 2. Lead, inspire and empower
 - a. You will communicate and model CCV's vision, mission and values clearly, passionately, powerfully and creatively with staff, leaders and church family members
 - b. You will lead the staff team, particularly the senior leadership team
 - c. You will work so that staff and leaders are committed to the vision, clear about their roles and objectives, motivated to perform and feel connected to each other and the church
 - d. You will inspire, equip and empower leaders from across the CCV church family to step into all God has for them, resourcing existing and new ministries
 - e. You will motivate healthy teamwork, good communication and mutual respect both in and between the various teams
 - f. You will be devoted to prayer and worship, ensuring these permeate your life and the life of the church
- 3. Teach in the power of the Holy Spirit
 - a. Working with the Teaching Pastor, you will set the teaching priorities and grow the internal teaching team
 - b. You will have and/or develop a network of speakers and partners within the Vineyard movement and beyond
 - c. You will teach regularly on Sunday and other times, communicating the word of God with excellence
 - d. You will maintain a focus on the supernatural: comfortable ministering in the presence and power of the Holy Spirit
- 4. Oversee spiritual formation and pastoral care
 - a. You are responsible for the spiritual health and growth of the church, bringing her progressively to a high and sustained standard of spiritual maturity

- b. You will work with the staff team to set a strategy for spiritual formation / discipleship and you will oversee how this is delivered
- c. You will work with the staff team to set a strategy for pastoral care and you will oversee how this is delivered
- 5. Maintain outward focus and oversee Vineyard Compassion (VC)
 - a. You will focus the church outwards and steer efforts to see our communities transformed through the power and love of Jesus, one life at a time
 - b. You will pray with and lead others into a personal relationship with Jesus, modelling this for the church
 - c. You will oversee the VC CEO and the strategic direction of VC
 - d. Together with staff and leaders you will build relationships with key community leaders and partners, working together to transform our communities as well as communities across the world as God leads
- 6. Manage CCV and VC responsibly
 - a. You will sit as a board member for both CCV and VC, keeping the board informed and presenting the vision, strategies and resource requirements of both organisations as well as monitoring and reporting progress
 - b. You will liaise as needed with the Vineyard overseer and the wider movement, receiving and providing support
 - c. You will oversee the effective working of all CCV (and VC) ministries in an integrated manner
 - d. Working with the Operations Director, you will manage CCV finance and budgets responsibly
 - e. Working with the Operations Director, you will oversee the management of staff and risk (including safeguarding, health & safety, etc), escalating as needed to the board and / or other responsible organisations
